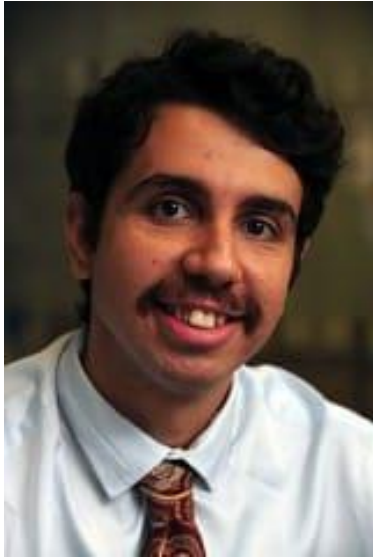


LANE BROOKES
